For the past three years, she has served as the New Hampshire representative on the staff working group for the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative, a proposed “cap and trade” program for limiting carbon dioxide emissions from major electric power plants in 10 eastern states. Her previous experience includes twelve years as an environmental consultant and four years as a Corporate Environmental Manager for The Timberland Company. Her previous environmental work ranged from Superfund litigation to monitoring overseas labor and environmental conditions.
