Dr. W. David Montgomery is Vice President of Charles River Associates and co-head of CRA's Energy and Environment Practice. He is an internationally recognized authority on economic issues in climate change policy, and one of the first contributors to the literature on emission trading. Dr. Montgomery was a Principal Lead Author of the Second Assessment Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), Working Group III, and the author of a number of peer-reviewed studies of climate change policy over the past decade. Dr. Montgomery directs the group at Charles River Associates that developed a set of widely respected economic models for the analysis of international, national, and industry impacts of proposed climate change policies. The U.S. Congress has requested his testimony on climate change issues on numerous occasions. He and his colleagues have been invited participants in IPCC expert workshops and studies assessing the economic impacts of proposed climate control policies on developing countries. Dr. Montgomery has led studies of climate change policy commissioned by the governments of Canada the United Kingdom as well as a number of trade associations and NGO's. He also advises private sector clients on incorporating future climate policies in their strategic planning process.

Dr. Montgomery has testified on behalf of clients at a variety of legislative and regulatory proceedings, including rulemakings by the U.S. Department of Energy and Environmental Protection Agency and the California Public Utilities Commission. His testimony on climate change policy and other energy issues has been requested on numerous occasions by Committees of the US Congress. Dr. Montgomery has been involved in a wide variety of litigation involving energy markets, including a number of antitrust cases and utility mergers.

Prior to joining Charles River Associates, Dr. Montgomery held a number of senior positions in the United States Government. He was Assistant Director of the U.S. Congressional Budget Office and Deputy Assistant Secretary for Policy in the U.S. Department of Energy during the Carter Administration. During the 1980s Dr. Montgomery was with the Energy Information Administration, where he was responsible for energy supply and demand forecasting activities, including world oil supply, demand and price projections. Dr. Montgomery has a Ph.D. in economics from Harvard University, and taught economics at Caltech and Stanford University.
