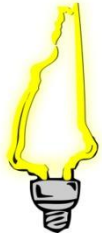




What is the program?

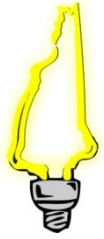
Energy Technical Assistance & Planning for New Hampshire Communities (ETAP) is a two year, federally funded program developed by the NH Office of Energy and Planning under the **Energy Efficiency & Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program**





ETAP Goals

- ▶ Assist participating NH communities to track and understand energy consumption in buildings and other major energy uses
- ▶ Provide a web-based tool to communities to benchmark energy performance
- ▶ Work with communities to identify and prioritize energy cost reduction opportunities
- ▶ Help develop strategies for energy cost reduction and secure technical and financial resources needed to realize energy savings



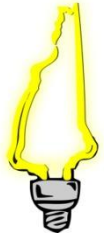

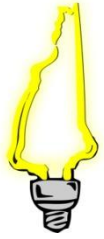

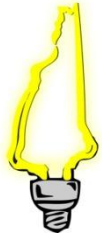
How will ETAP work?

- ▶ Conduct energy inventories for municipal uses
- ▶ Evaluate a municipality's status with regard to the Energy Efficiency & Sustainable Energy (EESSE) board's energy efficiency roadmap
- ▶ Provide technical assistance to municipalities based on assessed needs and priorities

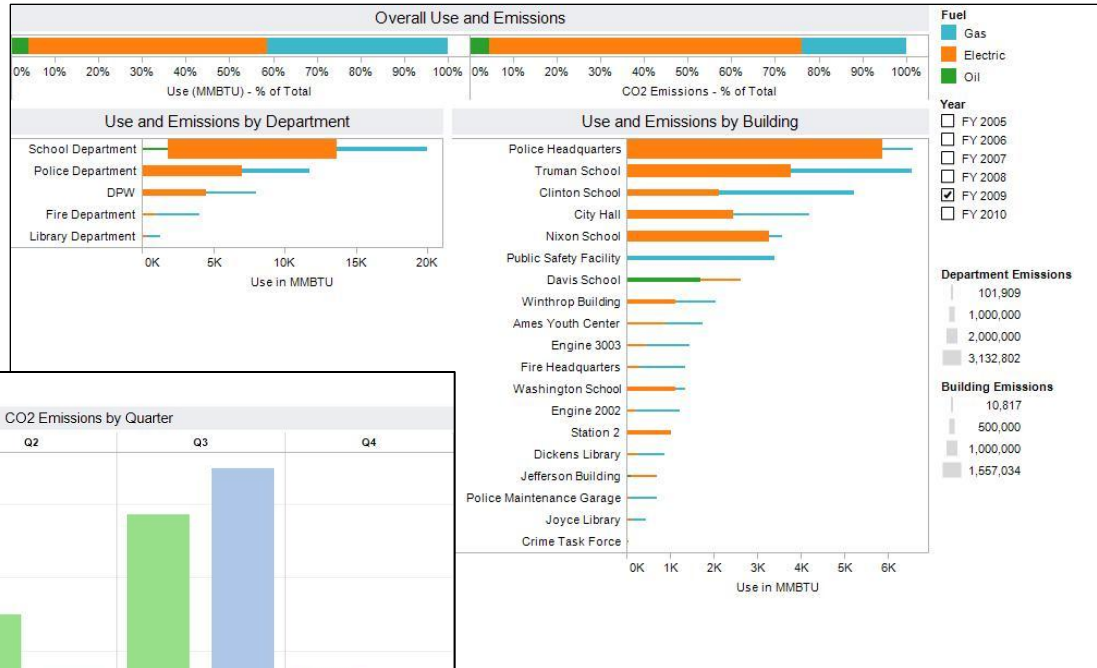


Types of Technical Assistance Available

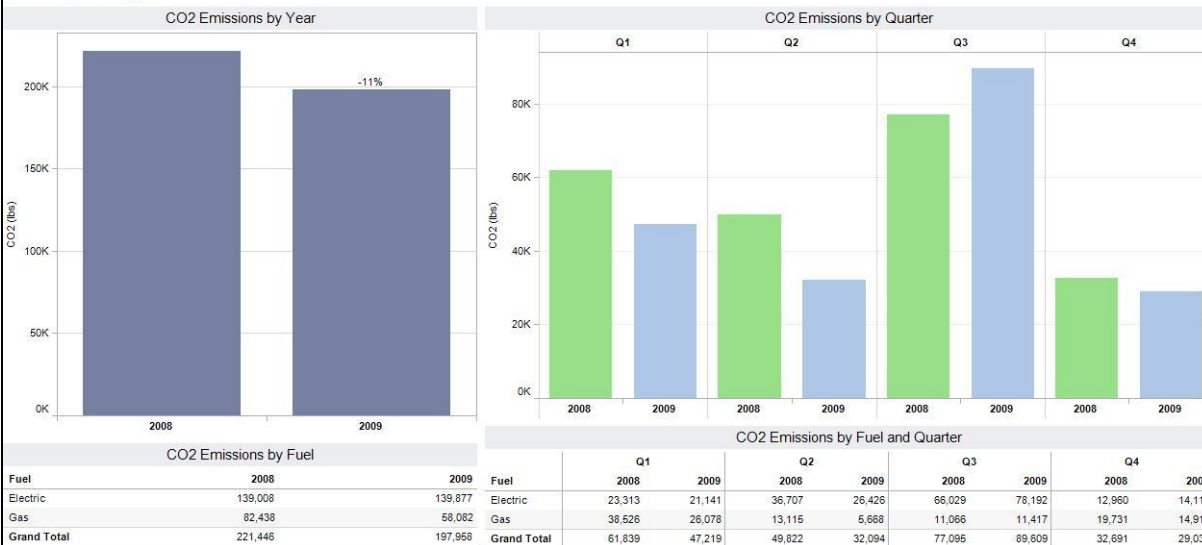
- ▶ Energy Inventories

- ▶ Assist with energy master plans and capital improvement plans for energy efficiency

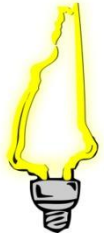


Peregrine Energy Insight Tool

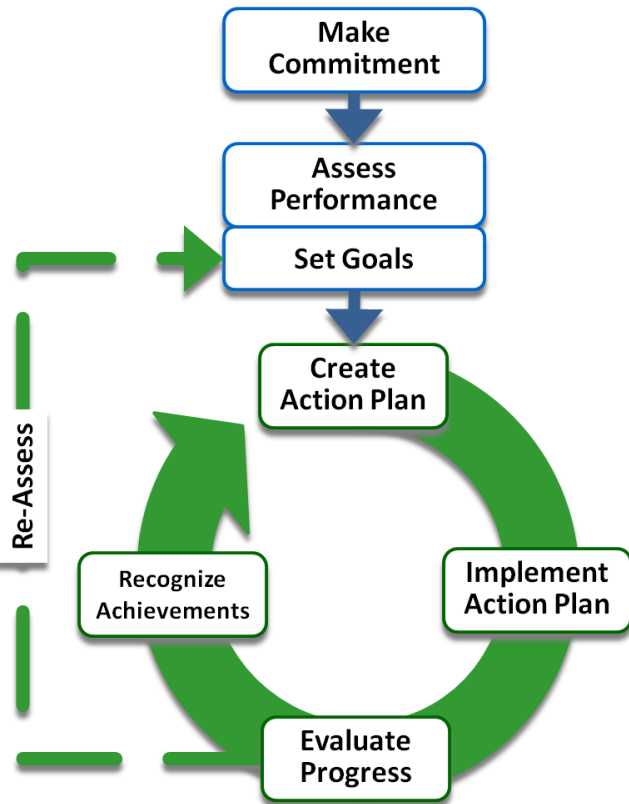

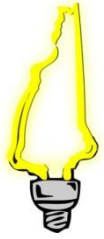




Community Commitment?
